Summary

I am Hope Van Vliet, a theatre artist, producer, and emerging dramaturg based in Regina, Saskatchewan, working primarily in devised and community-engaged theatre. Currently completing a BFA in Devised Theatre with a secondary major in Music at the University of Regina, my practice spans producing, technical theatre, stage management, and research-driven creation. Through my work with the Centre for Socially Engaged Theatre at the University of Regina, I research community theatre as a tool for access, dialogue, and collective storytelling, which directly informs my approach to collaboration and production. I have served as a producer with Regina Little Theatre, worked as a house technician and stage manager with Souris Valley Theatre, Working within a smaller theatre ecosystem has led me to actively seek out broader artistic influences while remaining committed to strengthening local infrastructure, with the long-term goal of building sustainable, ambitious theatre practices that allow artists to create meaningful work within their own communities.
